Hospice of Palm Beach County focuses on the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of every person in our program. An early referral to our program following a diagnosis of a serious illness enables patients and families to fully benefit from the support and services HPBC offers.

- Anyone facing the advancing stages of a serious illness may be eligible for Hospice care. All it takes is a telephone call.
- Anyone can call Hospice - patient, family member, friend or physician - Call us 24 hours a day / 7 days a week at **(561) 227-5140**.
- A Hospice admissions nurse will then be scheduled to meet the patient wherever he/she is - at home, skilled nursing or assisted living facility, or hospital.
- If an acute situation requires that the patient be transferred to one of HPBC's three inpatient units, we will provide the transportation.
- Hospice of Palm Beach County offers individuals and their loved ones choices to improve quality of life, regardless of ability to pay.
- Some of the diagnoses appropriate for admission to Hospice include:

Alzheimer's, Adult Failure to Thrive, Cancer, Cardiovascular Disease, Coma, End-stage Debility, End-stage Dementia, HIV/AIDS, Liver Disease, Lou Gehrig's disease (ALS), Multiple Sclerosis, Neuromuscular Disease, Parkinson's Disease, Pulmonary Disease, Renal Disease or Stroke.
