The fun starts Friday, July 27th with the Captains' Meeting and registration beginning at 5:30pm at the Riviera Beach Marina. Food, drink, raffles and entertainment will follow. On Saturday beginning at 6:30am, more than 200 anglers will fish for the largest Kingfish, Dolphin, Wahoo, Snapper and Grouper

while competing for more than \$50,000 in cash and prizes. New this year is the grand prize for the largest KDW by any angler: \$10,000 in cash and prizes. Anglers can leave from any inlet but must weigh in at the Riviera Beach Marina. The Tournament will culminate in the awards ceremony at 5:30 pm at the Riviera Beach Marina. WIRK Morning Host J.D. Pelletier will emcee the ceremony.
